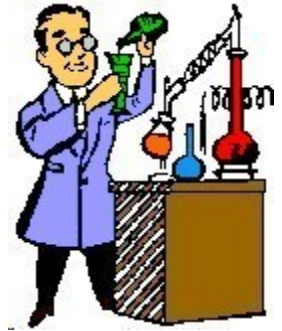

Forty years ago, Dr. George Sweeting, President of Moody Bible Institute, asked us as new MBI students, to consider the science ministry. Then over the years there were occasions where he would invite us to present the programs at MBI's Founder's Week and other conferences. This summer we had the privilege to give a special one night version of the Wonders of Science series including the Million Volts. The church secretary commented that, "We are sold out for tonight! I can't believe it! I wonder if we lost 50 tickets somewhere - people usually don't want to come back on Sunday evening." This shows that many people continue to have a great interest in how science and God's word relate.



Over the years we have had the privilege of presenting WOS to various corporate offices and their employees. Such was the case as we toured through Minnesota on our way west. One manufacturing company we visited has 2 divisions. One makes packaging machines that automatically package and box commercial items found in the consumer market.

The other division, Douglas Scientific, creates unique, specialized equipment to analyze DNA. When he realized we'd be available for another presentation if desired, he immediately asked us to talk with his team of international scientists working on the DNA equipment. The founder is a strong follower of Christ and his desire was to present the claims of Christ to his DNA engineers.

We were received very well and some of the scientists stayed afterwards for a couple of hours to ask questions. God had put on my heart to give a very special talk which they wanted to continue to discuss. It was so exciting to see these scientists interested in things they had not considered before. Several requested an ongoing dialogue to further investigate the points I brought up in the talk. These scientists are a bit beyond the "cutting edge" of the industry and I was so excited to be there at that particular time in their research. I was able to direct them to the Author Who made their work so challenging and exploding with possibilities undreamed of, as yet.



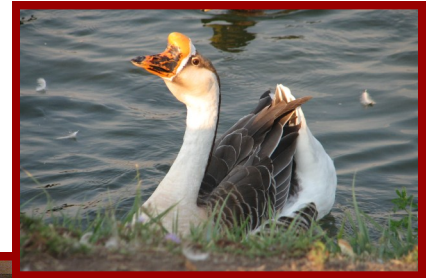

A young pastor and his family had just accepted a Lutheran Church parish in Enderlin, ND. We had met them previously at a Lutheran camp in Indiana. We were going to be passing near their new church in just a few weeks, as we were heading west to Montana. We offered to help introduce him to the community by making the WOS programs available so he could introduce and close the science programs nightly.

Though he had only given one Sunday message, we arrived in town and began to set up our equipment in the Community Auditorium for a Saturday evening program. I was also able to introduce the WOS programs in two churches the next day. Then I received an interesting phone call after Sunday evening's program.

The local public school principal had heard from some of his teachers about the science program they'd attended and he wondered if we would present an assembly for the school's science classes. I paused for a moment and then made a bold suggestion. "Since your school is only a block and a half away from the Community Auditorium, and being it's only the second day of school, why not give your teachers an interesting break and the students a special treat to get them excited about a new school year." They walked the entire school over and made it an all-school event. We were given the freedom to introduce concepts of a Creator and Designer in our universe to the students and faculty.

A large city TV station an hour away heard about it and FOX News sent a crew to Enderlin, ND to tape the assembly. The viewing audience of that broadcast numbered over 150,000. I began to receive emails from many who remembered us from our student days and earlier occasions of the presentations in that city. A number of requests for future programs came out of that broadcast.

We later heard from one of the Enderlin sponsors that their new pastor was asked by the "city fathers" to be available to present messages for some upcoming special events. We trust the Lord will use this pastor to impact many in his new community for Christ.

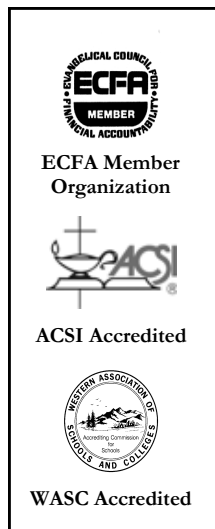

High School Youth Retreat in Great Falls, Montana

WOS was asked to step in to cover for a three day retreat which had lost it's speaker. We gave the first evening's program and another three programs all the next day.

The students were very, very attentive. Later I was told that they'd not had such in-depth content in any messages, nor such an unusual way of presenting the material. I was impressed with the depth of the questions asked after each presentation and their eagerness to learn.

The only draw-back were the many miles we had to drive on dusty gravel roads to get up the mountain and down again. I thought I'd be clever and Duct tape the back seams of the trailer to totally shut out the super fine smoke-like dust that billowed up from our tires and hung in the air for miles.

Were we ever surprised when we arrived at the paved road at the bottom of the mountains only to open the trailer and see everything absolutely totally covered in layers of dust! We got the Duct tape idea at the top of the mountain after noticing a thin film of dust on everything when we first unloaded. Well, that tape made matters totally worse when we went down. I couldn't imagine what had happened, so, I'll have to have a think and remember things about particle size, high to low pressure from Bernoulli effects, Boyle's Law, Charles' Law and Brownian motion with regard to micron sized particle migration. The high school science teacher and I had the most delightful time together for the week. We shared ideas for class experiments and how to build various demos for class. His classes would be ones that I'd look forward to auditing!
