Apparently the initial program speaker had a conflict and wouldn't be available. The youth director for the church called the program director at Moody Northwest, Moody Bible Institute's extension campus located in 4th Memorial's complex. She



remembered a chapel we'd presented several years before and how the staff and students kept talking about it for weeks afterwards. The youth director made the call and everything fell into place. The students remained focused for the 90 minute program and asked some well thought out questions afterwards.

Since Moody used the church's facility for their campus, I immediately called my friend, Dr. Jack Lewis, Campus Dean, to see if he might desire another chapel presentation to the current student population. It turns out that the following day concluding my responsibilities with the youth at 4th Memorial Church, Dr. Lewis was scheduled as chapel speaker. He enthusiastically gave up his spot to provide the students with the Wonders of Science experience.

I began my message by stating that 44 years ago I was sitting in their current place as a new student at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, wondering what the Lord had in store for my wife and me as we had recently given our lives over to the Lord. What possible business does a converted scientist have at a Bible College? I didn't know that my predecessor, Dr. George Speake, was in the audience at that Founder's Week. He was discussing retirement with then President Dr. George Sweeting, who had requested his presence at Founder's Week (in February, in

Chicago!). Dr. Speake was there to "check out" a young scientist who came as a student wondering how God might use him in the Lord's work. And the rest is history!

The main thought I reinforced with the chapel students was to not squander their future lives in empty pursuits, but to be available to use the gifts the Lord has given them for His crucial work. The Founder's Week speaker at the chapel I attended was the late Dr. Dave Breese. During my personal meeting with him after his message, he prayed with me and paraphrased Mordecai's exhortation to Esther, "It is perhaps for this reason that the Lord has raised you up at this time in our nation." I was overwhelmed by student responses to my message saying that it was exactly what they needed to hear. Their commitment and confidence was raised exponentially to face the unknown future with expectation rather than uncertainty.
