

OUR "CHARIOT" ARRIVES

For over ten years we've been blessed with the use of a fantastic vehicle. A foundation provided us with a 1999 Chevy Suburban. It has hauled a heavy trailer filled with our demonstration equipment for 130,000 miles over every imaginable terrain, through all kinds of weather without a single problem, save for an alternator replacement.

That failure occurred in the "middle of nowhere". Yet the Lord had gone before us. The only garage in the small town where we had stopped for lunch had exactly the right part. The owner had ordered the wrong alternator for a customer. He was sure he would be "stuck" with it, however, it was exactly the one we needed for our larger Suburban. We were on our way in less than an hour!



We had to put 500 miles on the truck before pulling a trailer, then another 500 at 55mph or less before stressing the engine at gradually higher speeds. By the time we were halfway across the US, we were up to typical highway speeds. We made excellent time over Easter break from school to the east New Jersey coast to be the keynote speaker in early June for a home school convention at Harvey Cedars Conference Grounds.

At the end of the trip I checked the oil again and after 3,300 miles we'd only used 8 oz. in the new engine! It had been broken in perfectly and is "tight as a drum" so we expect another long use of the Lord's provided equipment, should He tarry.

Thank you to everyone who prayed for the truck's provision, and supporting us financially by covering all the extra fees that typically accompany such a purchase.



PRISON MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

Through our presentations at several of the nation's correctional facilities including Folsum, Leavenworth, Terminal Island and various maximum security sites and military brigs, we have had on-going contact with inmates over the years. We send them various Bible studies, sermon notes, science/Bible apologetics and tracts. In one maximum security prison, one inmate trusted Christ for salvation and began to witness to others. Since his conversion, he has been responsible for initiating different Bible studies in several of the eight wings of the prison. As inmates "get saved" they at times are transferred to outlying dorms where they start another Bible study patterned after the original one they attended.

Please pray for these inmates who are earnestly trying to walk closely with the Lord in a constantly hostile environment. Those of us accustomed to "life on the outside" have no concept of what some of these men and women have to endure. Pray particularly for two "gang enforcers" who recently professed faith in Jesus, coming out of their Middle Eastern culture. In prison, there is nowhere to hide for safety except in the Lord.

Duplicate materials are not allowed to be received, so I send a different set of tracts along with Bible studies and articles to each inmate and then they in turn share them with others, much like the early church did as they passed letters from one church to another.

For some of these inmates coming out of bondage, a conversion to Jesus means they are marked for death. Don't forget to pray for their protection and faithful walk with the Lord.
